- 1. The key Principles of the RFL 100% Me Anti-Doping Policy are to:
- · Uphold and preserve the ethics of Rugby League
- Safeguard the mental and physical health of players
- Ensure that all players have the opportunity to compete equally
- 2. We acknowledge that so called performance enhancing substances and social substances carry health risks, and we will endeavour to inform our players of the associated risks.
- 3. We acknowledge that all Rugby League players have to abide by the Operational Rules, and as such may be tested be UK Sport. We also acknowledge that doping is an offence and may be punishable by suspension of up to 2 years for a first offence.
- 4. The Club will ensure all of our players are aware of this policy and the endorsement that the club has given.
- 5. The Club supports the RFL's Anti-Doping Whistle Blowing Policy. This club will report any allegations of ant-doping to the RFL.
